- 1. Start of indoor season
 - a. Coach Orientation
 - Carly: We held a coach orientation on October 27th. There were 17 coaches in attendance. We went over Kinsmen P & P, answered questions, was provided with feedback & had beneficial discussions on facility access, lane designations and schedule.
- 2. Track Monitor Update
