# Facility Behaviour Policy

The following outlines the policies regarding use of the shared space at the Foote Field Dome. These behaviours are required for continued access to the facility.

All coaches, athletes and associate club members must act and communicate in a respectful manner to other members, as well as members of the public and facility staff who may be in the area. Infractions are encouraged to be reported to the ETFC Board or Coordinator.

Failure to act in a respectful manner as described above, will result in a 3-Strike Warning, and then the individual will be asked to leave and refrain from using ETFC booked space until further notice.

# General Rules

The following are general rules for using the track during an ETFC booking:

- <u>All coaches are required to check-in</u> at the front desk of the Foote Field Dome before their club enters the facility.
- Any persons wanting to cross the track at any time must always watch for any oncoming athletes and actively stay out of the way.
- Due to crowding and insurance purposes. Family/friends of athletes are not permitted in the Dome during ETFC bookings.
- All athletes and coaches using the facility must be current Athletics Alberta members.
- All athlete and coaches are required to wait outside of the Dome until ETFC bookings begin.
- No sleds are permitted in the facility.
- Lane 4 will be a designated walking lane.

# **Booking Times**

The track and long jump pit in Foote Field Dome are booked during the following times from December 2, 2023– April 25, 2024:

- Mon Thurs: 5:00 8:00PM
- Saturdays: 9:30 PM 12:30 PM
- Sunday \*Only on Jan. 28 1-3:30pm when Saturday is not available

#### \*Extended Use Charges\*

Access to your booked space is defined on our rental agreement. This means clubs are not to access booked space until your booking time starts, and you must be completely vacated and

have all equipment cleaned up by the end of your booked time. Should you exceed your rental time, extended use charges may be applied to the club.

#### Shared Use Schedule

As per the 2023 AGM, the ETFC membership has decided to only permit one club to use the Dome at a time unless numbers allow, and coaches pre-arrange to share the space. All bookings MUST be indicated in the Team Up Calendar as per below.

Booking options will be:

M- Th: 5-6:30pm OR 6:30-8pm

Saturday: 9:30-11am; 11-12:30pm (unless otherwise coordinated between coaches)

## How to Book a Lane:

- If your club would like to use the Foote Field Dome, coaches must book their club through the shared calendar at the following link: <u>https://teamup.com/ks1fba50af4b757318</u>.
- 2. When adding your club into the shared calendar, please state: (1) Coach name, (2) The number of athletes, (3) Events which will you be training
- 3. The deadline for bookings for the following week are on **<u>Fridays</u>**. This is to give coaches proper notice of the accurate number of athletes that will be using the facility.

# Equipment

- Clubs may not store equipment at the facility at this time.
- Hurdles & starting blocks will be provided by Foote Field.
- At no time, may Foote Field equipment leave the Dome.
- The use of sleds is not permitted in the facility.

## Items on track

Items places on track must be made visible to athletes by placing pylons on/in front of item to alert athletes of item ahead of time.

# Long Jump Pit

Please ensure you rake the long jump pit after use.

# Throwing

Throwing is not permitted at anytime in the Dome.

## Field

The ETFC does not currently book the field. Therefore, ETFC members are NOT permitted on the field at anytime during ETFC bookings.
